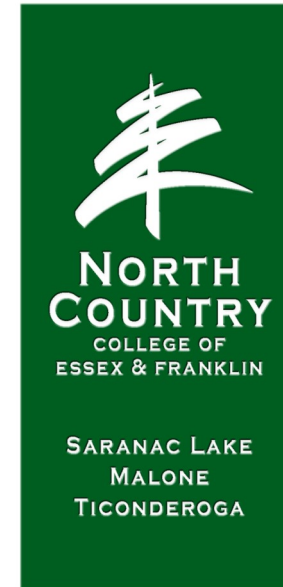

Important Things to Consider When Applying for Scholarships.

1. Read the requirements carefully. Many scholarships require you to have a minimum GPA, be a resident of a specific county, enrolled in a specific degree program and similar restrictions.
2. If a personal statement is required, be sure to address the theme identified by the scholarship.
3. Meet all deadlines and other requirements. Failure to meet deadlines can automatically disqualify you from being considered.
4. Remember that many students apply for the same scholarship. You are competing for the award. Be realistic in your expectations based upon your academic performance and the quality of your application.
5. Apply for all scholarships that are appropriate to you as a student.

How Scholarships Affect Your Federal and State Financial Aid

Every student who attends NCCC has a Cost of Attendance (COA) budget designed for them based on the type of student (full or part-time, off-campus/on-campus, dependant, independent, etc) they are while in attendance.

Federal regulations only allow a student to receive financial aid totaling up to their full COA budget.

When you receive a scholarship, this is included as part of your total academic year eligibility for financial aid and is applied to your COA budget.

If you already received 100% financial aid to meet your COA budget and you are then awarded a scholarship, the Financial Aid Office must do one or a combination of the following based on your specific circumstances.

- ◆ Reduce your Parent Loan by your scholarship award amount.
- ◆ Reduce your Unsubsidized Student Loan by your scholarship award amount.
- ◆ Reduce your Subsidized Loan by your scholarship award amount.
- ◆ Reduce your work-study award by your scholarship award amount.
- ◆ Reduce your SEOG award by your scholarship award amount.

These reductions occur to prevent you from exceeding your COA budget. If you received less than 100% financial aid to meet your COA, you may be exempt from any reductions in other forms of aid. This is determined on a case-by-case basis.

New York Students Only

Students who are New York State Residents and receiving a TAP Award and Tuition ONLY scholarship will have their TAP Award reduced by the amount of their scholarship. This is required by the Higher Education Service Corporation/NYS TAP regulations.

REMEMBER!
Scholarships & Grants are always more desirable than any type of LOANS!
