

SUMMARY:

Case numbers have declined within the SUNY system overall in the last three weeks. The positivity rate peaked at 0.90% on Sept. 13 but is currently 0.40%. However, **the North Country region still has the highest positivity rate (5.4 %) in the state**. Please continue to wear your mask and self-screen for any Covid-19 symptoms.

WATCH FOR SYMPTOMS

If you have any of the following symptoms, do not come to campus and call your medical provider:

- Cough
- Shortness of Breath
- Fever or Chills
- Muscle Pain
- Headache
- Sore Throat
- New Loss of Taste or Smell

Any student who tests positive is required to quarantine/isolate, per health department guidelines. The college will notify Essex or Franklin county, depending on the campus the student is attending, and the county will conduct the necessary contact tracing.


