SPRING 2022 GUIDANCE:

Per the State University of New York (SUNY), all students planning to be on campus for Spring 2022 are required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 with one of the three approved vaccines.

If you were enrolled for the fall semester and already submitted proof of vaccination, you're set. If you are an incoming student who will be on campus, the deadline to submit proof of vaccination is Friday, Jan. 14th, 2022.

Proof of vaccination can be submitted to <u>healthrecords@nccc.edu</u>.

Students planning to be on-campus for Spring 2022 who have not submitted proof of vaccination or have not been granted a medical or religious exemption, will be unable to attend on-campus classes, reside in the residence halls or access the college facilities during the semester.



VACCINATION PROGRESS TO DATE:

The map below shows the percent of North Country population (by county) with at least one vaccine dose, according to the state Health Department. **The statewide rate for at least one vaccine dose is 77.5**



ON-CAMPUS VACCINATION RATES (ALL NCCC CAMPUSES)

A total of **456 of 457 on-campus students are fully vaccinated**. One unvaccinated student has been granted medical accommodations. The remaining student population is fully online. More than 90 percent of fulltime faculty and staff are vaccinated.
