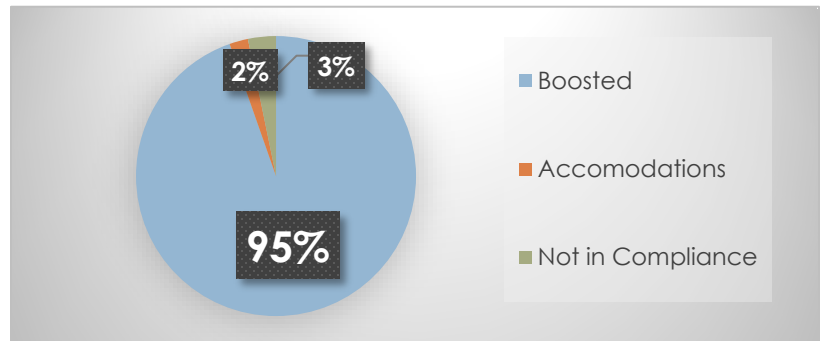
## NCCC POSITIVE COVID CASES (ALL CAMPUSES)

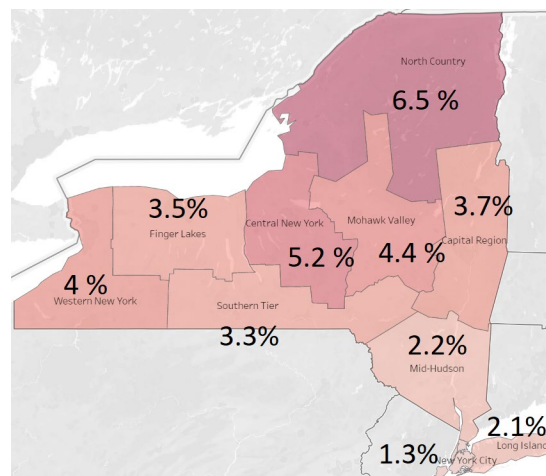

## REGIONAL POSITIVITY UPDATE:



Reported positive cases across New York continue to decline, although **the North Country still has the highest regional positivity rate in the state** at 6.5 percent. Two weeks ago, the North Country's positivity rate topped 9 percent.
