Clinical/Field Internship: There will be a minimum 24-hour hospital-based emergency room rotation (with possible addition of Pre op time for IV skills based on skill level) and a minimum 120-hour ambulance field internship (with opportunity for additional hours) during the second half of the course. We will be using the Jones Bartlett LMS for Hours and Skills tracking. A separate hospital orientation and health requirements as set by the hospital need to be completed prior to any hospital clinicals. Field internship letters will be sent when cleared for field internship time will include allowed skills.

Grading: There are 8 Module exams (80%), along with online Interactive lectures and quizzes, for every chapter and the Cumulative Course Final is the remaining (20%) which you must obtain a 70% or higher for course completion and eligibility to proceed to the NYS practical skills exam.

Requirements: To be eligible to proceed on to the State certifying exam the student must: complete all on-line assignments, provide completion certificates for (ICS-100, ICS-200, NIMS-700 and IS-5A courses) taken from the FEMA site, obtain at least a "C" grade (75%), complete the CPR for Healthcare Provider course, and complete the observation.
