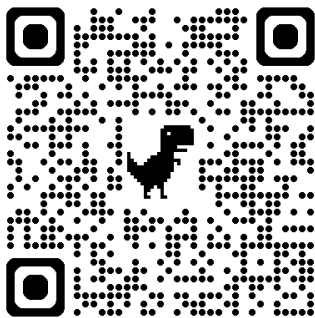


Earn a FREE DSP Frontline Supervisor Credential

The NYS Office for People with Developmental Disabilities (OPWDD) and the State of New York (SUNY) partnered to offer a high-quality education that supports the work of Direct Support Professional Frontline Supervisors (FLS). *Staff need to be in a FLS role, or have access to “shadow” a FLS to be eligible.

Is it really free?

Yes! The NYS grant covers tuition, fees and books. You'll also receive an incentive of **\$750** upon successful completion of the Frontline Supervisor microcredential.



PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Online Classes: The two classes required for the FLS microcredential are HUS 114: Supervision and Leadership in Human Services (3 credits) and PSY 138: Psychology of Personal Relations (3 credits). Both classes “stack” into an associate’s degree at NCCC! National Certification. Coursework is aligned with the requirements for certification from the [National Alliance for Direct Support Professionals \(NADSP\)](https://www.nadsp.org/).
