



AS Wilderness Recreation Leadership

At the completion of this degree program, students will be able to do the following:

1. Students will be able to identify and articulate a code of ethics as related to the field of outdoor recreation and make professional and personal decisions based on this ethical framework.
2. Students will be able to articulate how the outdoor recreation subspecialty fits into the larger discipline of recreation.
3. Students will be able to apply management concepts in an outdoor recreation context.
4. Students will be able to demonstrate awareness of legal issues that affect the outdoor recreation industry such as liability, negligence, use of waivers and assumption of risk forms.
5. Students will be able to consider environmental and social issues when making decisions related to outdoor recreation programming.
6. Students will be able to apply and maintain a working knowledge of environmental science topics and incorporate these topics into outdoor recreation programming.
7. Students will be able to articulate a personal philosophy regarding wilderness and understand current wilderness issues & management techniques.
8. Students will be able to understand the experiential education process and plan & implement effective experiential lessons.
