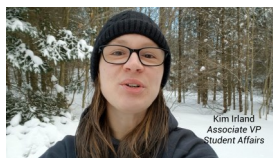


Welcome to the Spring 2021 semester!

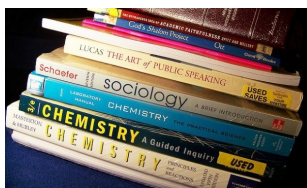
