Whether you're new to the college community or a returning student, welcome to the start of the Fall 2020 semester! Thank you for choosing North Country.

As a means to ensure the health and safety of the college community, most classes will be delivered in an online format this semester. Here are a few highlights of our plans:

- All operations will be conducted remotely until Sept. 14. For students, that
 means no campus access (except for bookstore curbside pickup) for the first
 two weeks of the semester.
- Some courses will have live online meetings while others will be fully online.
- Daily screening and masks will be required for any in-person classes.
- Appointments to access in-person tutoring, library services, and computer lab will be possible after Sept. 14.
