



AGREEMENT BETWEEN CHAMPLAIN VALLEY TECHNICAL EDUCATION CENTER (CV-TEC) AND

NORTH COUNTRY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

The intent of this articulation agreement is to foster an ongoing relationship between North Country Community College and the Champlain Valley Education Services (CV-TEC), which will enable both institutions to meet the needs of their students. This agreement will prevent unnecessary duplication of instruction and will allow the student from CV-TEC who attends North Country Community College to receive transfer credit for coursework taken as a part of the *Security and Law Enforcement* curriculum at CV-TEC.

After evaluation of course outlines and requirements within the CV-TEC Security and Law Enforcement program, North Country Community College agrees to award transfer credits to students who have completed the CV-TEC Security and Law Enforcement program and are admitted to North Country Community College for the following courses:

CV-TEC	North Country Community College	Credit Hours
Security and Law Enforcement	CRJ 101 Introduction to Criminal Justice	3
Security and Law Enforcement	CRJ 102 Police in Contemporary Society	3
Security and Law Enforcement	CRJ 208 Criminal Investigation	3

The process for the student wishing to receive transfer credits is as follows:

- 1. Notify the North Country Community College Admissions representative of their intent to attend the College and request that the transfer credit be granted.
- Request the CV-TEC Guidance Office to send program results (indicating Program Final Grades), report card, Employability Profile, or any other assessments to the Admissions Office on the Saranac Lake Campus. (Admissions, North Country Community College, PO Box 89, 23 Santanoni Avenue, Saranac Lake, NY 12983).

The articulation agreement may be reviewed at the request of either party and contains no expiration date. Each party is responsible for notification of programmatic changes when they occur.

All other enrollment eligibility requirements must be met by incoming students in a timely fashion. This agreement does not guarantee enrollment. The full requirements for admission are published in the NCCC catalog – www.nccc.edu.
